Improved Front Entrance

The test reconfiguration of our main entrance has been completed. Because of the sharp curve of the exit lane at our main entrance, trucks have always had difficulty navigating the curve without running onto the lawn or the island, damaging the curbs and the turf, and potentially the gate. The test configuration aims to remedy this.

The once exit lane has been closed off and the once center entrance lane has been converted to the exit lane. Trucks can now use the main entrance to exit the property and drive straight out.

There will still be instances when several vehicles may be waiting to gain access through the main gate. Those with a remote or key card can always use the secondary entrance should they choose not to wait. If you are exiting and another vehicle appears to be trying to enter through the exit side after you have left, you can slow down or stop until the exit gate has begun its closing cycle.

As was approved at a previous Board Meeting, this reconfiguration will remain in place until June 1, at which time, the Board will consider if the trial has been successful and if to make it permanent.

Pets On Leashes

Per our Rules & Regulations, all pets must be on a leash or be carried whenever outside a Unit. This includes dogs and cats. Residents allowing a pet outside without a leash are subject to a fine. This rule also applies to guests with pets.



Late Fees and Interest Reinstated

Unit Owners should now have set up a payment method for their monthly maintenance assessments. Beginning April 11, late fees and interest will again be accessed to accounts that are delinquent. If you have issues setting up your payment method, contact the Property Manager.

Unregistered Vehicles and Parking

We have begun citing vehicles parked on the Association property that do not have an Arbor Grove parking decal or a visitor hang tag. **We appreciate the response from Residents to remedy the issue.**

As a reminder, all vehicles (including motorized scooters) that are parked on Association property must be registered with the Association and have a parking decal, or for a visitor, a visitor hang tag displayed in the vehicle whenever parked on the property. Residents may not use a visitor hang tag in lieu of registering a vehicle and putting a parking decal on it.

New Alterations Review Process

There is a new Alterations Review Request form available on Vantaca. This new form replaces the ARC form previously used. A permit will be issued to the Unit Owner upon Board approval of a Request. This permit must be displayed in the appropriate window of the Unit, or on the door if windows are being replaced, during the period of the alteration, and then returned to the Property Office upon completion of the alteration.

The purpose of the displayed permit is to give the Property Manager, the Board, and Unit Owners a visual cue that the work being done in a Unit has been properly reviewed and approved.

New Documents on Vantaca

Revised Association forms and the comprehensive Governing Documents (now searchable) are available on Vantaca. Documents with the word "Form" at the end of the file name can be completed using the free Adobe Acrobat Reader app. Be sure to first download the file to your computer and then open it with Acrobat Reader to fill in the form fields. The forms available on Vantaca will always be the most current versions.
