

Do More from Your Online Vantaca Account

Forms

When you need an Arbor Grove form, always download the latest version from **Vantaca**. As revisions are made to forms, the current versions are always posted on Vantaca. You can find forms by logging into your **online Vantaca account** and selecting *Documents*, then *Forms*.

One of the new forms is the *Non-Owner Occupancy Application* that should be used going forward for annual rentals and annual renewals, short-term rentals and returns, roommates, or family members living with a Unit Owner on a permanent basis. For short-term family or guest visitations, please submit a *Visitor Registration* form.

Service Requests

Request or ARC Request.

You can now submit requests for service directly in Vantaca. This feature allows Owners to submit billing questions and late fee waiver requests, service/maintenance requests, and general questions. You can also submit an *Alterations Review Request*, but you must upload your completed *Alterations Review Request* form with your request. This helps us better track and monitor requests and work progress, and does not require the time of a phone call. From your online Vantaca account, select *My Items*, then *Submit a Request*, and then either *General*

New Flood Insurance Documents

The new Flood Insurance documents for 2024 are now available in Vantaca. You can download the documents by logging into your online Vantaca account and selecting *Documents*, then *Insurance Policies*.

Cancel Maintenance Payments when Selling

As part of a sale of your Unit, be sure to cancel any auto payment method you have established for paying your monthly maintenance assessments. This includes auto bill pay or auto debit. You can cancel an auto debit via your online Vantaca account.

Application Fee for Lease Renewals and Returning Short-Term Renters

At the May Meeting of the Board of Directors, the Board approved a \$25 application processing fee for annual renter renewals and for short-term renter(s) returning to Arbor Grove. Annual rental renewals and short-term rentals for returning Residents require a completed *Non-Owner Occupant Application* for each rental period and the new \$25 processing fee, effective immediately.



Alternate Ways to Keep Your AC Drain Line Clean

The March newsletter included a reminder to Unit Owners about the AC drain line cleaning. In addition to the monthly vinegar/hot water method of cleaning, there are other options. One option are drain line treatment tabs (thanks JT for suggesting these). The tabs are put in the drain line and can work for up to two months. Another option, especially useful for Unit Owners that are not on the property for extend periods of time, is the iFlo Smart Activated AC Drain Line Cleaning System that uses a cartridge of cleaning solution to clean the drain line continuously for up to three months. The device can also connect to your wifi network and be monitored via a mobile app.



Lock Your Mailbox

Some mailboxes have been left unlocked or have not been closed completely before locking, and wind and the opening and closing of the panels has caused some mailbox doors to break off. **Be sure your mailbox door is completely closed and locked after getting your mail!** If you need a new lock/key for your mailbox, you can get a new lock for \$25. Contact the office for more information.



Parking on Property Roadways

Parking on property roadways is not permitted for any length of time. If you are picking up mail, use the parking spaces near the mailboxes, do not park on the roadway inside the main gate.
